Harry: When the war started in September I thought it was the duty of every young man to enlist so therefore, I was married in 1938 incidentally, so I joined up practically immediately in 1939.

Interviewer: And how did your wife feel about that?

Harry: Well, she was quite, well, I wouldn't say happy but she realised what I wanted to do because I was at the time I was twenty five at the time in 1939. I didn't want to be called up. I wanted to join what I wanted to join so therefore I remembered the First World War the infantry had a very bad time and also I was a driver. I was able to drive so I joined the RASC.
