You got no blackouts, no 'Draw those curtains!', you know, that 'Don't go and play down there!' There's a change completely, you see, you could then go and leave the curtains open, lights would — it wouldn't matter about the lights being on or anything like. You could run off down the road and no worries about anything like that. In that way you got freedom back if you like, although freedom wasn't really taken away as such but you got that extra freedom, if you like, and you could go and do the things that you couldn't do during the war, obviously, you know. That — that I suppose another good thing that you could do, you know, something was — yeah. That made a hell of a difference I think, really, you know, that you could do these things.
